on **April 7th** (*Students’ Session*) and **8th** (*Young Researchers’ Session*) **2016**

The organizers invite proposals on all themes related to **Aegean Archaeology**, that is Aegean areas and cultures in the Bronze Age (i.e. art, crafts, everyday life, social/funerary/political landscapes, long-distance relations, Aegeans overseas, impact on other cultures, etc.), also in a broader context (new methods/approaches/technologies applied to the research, new technologies in data/research/site management, etc.). Proposals are welcomed from students (for the *Students’ Session*) and PhD students or candidates and scholars who have recently completed doctoral research (for the *Young Researchers’ Session*).

The proposals for **20 min.** lectures should consist of an **abstract in English** (or **Polish** in case of the *Students’ Session*) of **max. 500 words**.

The provisional program of the Conference will be announced in the second half of February.
